We use will to talk about the future or to make a prediction about the future.

Examples :

- 1- I will go to the market tomorrow.
- 2- They will have a holiday next year.
- 3- Salem will buy a new car.

Negative

Will + not + an inf v.

Examples :

- 1- It won't be hot tomorrow.
- 2- The meeting won't be at 3 o'clock.
- 3- They won't paint the house.
