- Cats
- Trees

2. We add **-es** when nouns end with **-x, -s, -sh, -ch** and **-o**:

✎ Ex:

- Bus → Buses
- Box → Boxes
- Watch → Watches

3. When the nouns end with **-f** or **-fe**, we delete them and add **-ves**

- ### ✎ Ex:
- Wolf → Wolves
 - Shelf → Shelves
 - Knife → Knives

4. There are some irregular nouns

- ### ✎ Ex:
- Man → Men
 - Woman → Women
 - Child → Children
 - Foot → Feet
 - Tooth → Teeth
 - Mouse → Mice
 - Sheep → Sheep
 - Fish → Fish
 - Goose → Geese
 - ox → oxen



- She likes oranges.

-When the subject is plural **we/they/you** or the pronoun **I**, we do not add anything to the verb

✂ **Ex:**

➤ **The boys like football.**

➤ **I like music.**



